Cascade Clamp - Founded in Portland, Oregon in 1943, the Cascade Manufacturing Company started as a small machine shop hiring just four people. Overall sales for that particular year totaled \$60,000. The very first recorded sales revenues involved the assembly and machining of stainless steel valves, pipe fittings and different parts. During five years of operation, the business had expanded to 40 workers and their annual sales volume had risen to 330 thousand dollars. These days, Cascade is amongst the leading global manufacturers in the material handling industry.

Design and production of the company's first hydraulic cylinder allowed this new company to aggressively pursue better business possibilities. Throughout the last 60 years, the industry of material handling has grown into a very sophisticated area with Cascade proudly playing a part in its progress. Cascade presently continues to grow as the best supplier of lift truck attachments and various related products. The business feels assured in their capability to be able to continue to lead the way within the business by understanding client's needs in the future and remaining competitive within the international market.

All through the 1950's, Cascade started to make, design, and promote its hydraulic attachments. A new facility was built in 1956, in order to accommodate all plant operations and offices in Portland, Oregon, which remains to be the company's present headquarters. After 15 years of business, total workers reached 180 staff and sales had reached nearly 2.3 million dollars.

In the year 1959 in Springfield, Amarillo a second manufacturing plant was built. The year 1960 marked Cascade's initial move into the global world of the material handling industry when the company recognized interest in Australia, the Netherlands and England.

The business changed its name to Cascade Corporation in the year 1964. In the year 1965, Cascade went public with a preliminary offering of two hundred thousand shares of common stock. The company has expanded its production plants throughout the U.S. with locations in Warner Robins, Georgia, Portland, Oregon and Springfield, Amarillo. Cascade merchandise are made globally because of lots of subsidiary operations. In the year 1944, a brand new plant was completed in Almere, the Netherlands which is Cascade's European command center. This facility is made to be the ultimate customer support centre.

Cascade further expanded their product base in the year 1996 and 1997 subsequent to acquiring 5 corporations, which included the Kenhar Corporation, the global leader in forks.
